NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough supports the incorporation of Nikiski as a home rule city within the boundaries decided by the Local Boundary Commission.
- **SECTION 2.** That copies of this resolution be distributed to the Commissioner of the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development.
