

Gross Patient Revenue – FY2017 (Est.)



Net Patient Revenue – FY2017 (Est.)



Net Income – FY2017 (Est.)



(in thousands)



(Charity & Bad Debt, in thousands)






Charity Care & Bad Debt FY 2017

- \$3.927M in 2014/15/16 Series Bond/Escrow Payments
- \$6.15M in Cash transfers to Plant Replacement
