

Gross Patient Revenue – FY2018



Net Patient Revenue – FY2018







(Charity & Bad Debt, in thousands)






Charity Care & Bad Debt FY 2018

- \$975K in 2014/15/16 Series Bond/Escrow Payments
- \$4.2M in Cash transfers to Plant Replacement

 - Pharmacy Expansion
 - Expand Materials Management + Loading Docks
 - Complete "Back of House Corridor" (patient privacy)

 - AK Hospital Data Only (hospital names removed)






189 - PULMONARY EDEMA & RESPIRATORY FAILURE






191 - CHRONIC OBSTRUCTIVE PULMONARY DISEASE W CC






192 - CHRONIC OBSTRUCTIVE PULMONARY DISEASE W/O CC/MCC






194 - SIMPLE PNEUMONIA & PLEURISY W CC






195 - SIMPLE PNEUMONIA & PLEURISY W/O CC/MCC






291 - HEART FAILURE & SHOCK W MCC






292 - HEART FAILURE & SHOCK W CC






293 - HEART FAILURE & SHOCK W/O CC/MCC






309 - CARDIAC ARRHYTHMIA & CONDUCTION DISORDERS W CC






378 - G.I. HEMORRHAGE W CC






392 - ESOPHAGITIS, GASTROENT & MISC DIGEST DISORDERS W/O MCC





460 - SPINAL FUSION EXCEPT CERVICAL W/O MCC






470 - MAJOR JOINT REPLACEMENT OR REATTACHMENT OF LOWER EXTREMITY W/O MCC




603 - CELLULITIS W/O MCC






683 - RENAL FAILURE W CC






690 - KIDNEY & URINARY TRACT INFECTIONS W/O MCC






871 - SEPTICEMIA OR SEVERE SEPSIS W/O MV 96+ HOURS W MCC
