RE: Amendments to Resolution 2018-008, Supporting House Bill 287

Providing Early Approval of Funding for Public Education and Student

Transportation (Cooper)

I would like to amend Resolution 2018-008 to update it to reflect recent actions taken by the legislature and make a clarification. Additionally, I have filed an updated memorandum in support of this resolution.

(Please note that the underlined bold language is new and crossed out bold language is to be deleted.)

> Amend the 5th whereas clause as follows:

WHEREAS, House Bill 287 would appropriate funds for public education and transportation of students but passed the House Finance Committee without a funding source by making appropriations from the constitutional budget reserve fund; and

> Amend the 6th whereas clause as follows:

WHEREAS, according to <u>one of</u> the sponsors, <u>Representative Paul Seaton</u>, the intent of House Bill 287 is to make early funding available for school districts and regional education attendance areas; and

Insert a new Section 2 as follows:

**SECTION 2.** The borough assembly urges the Senate to identify a funding source and pass HB 287.

Renumber old section 2 to section 3 and amend by inserting Senator Gary Stevens' name as follows:

**SECTION 2 3.** That copies of this resolution shall be provided to Governor Bill Walker, Senator Peter Micciche, **Senator Gary Stevens**, Representative Mike Chenault, Representative Gary Knopp and Representative Paul Seaton.
