KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2018-32

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ASSET TRANSFER OF A DIESEL GENERATOR AND MOBILE TRAILER FROM THE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TO THE MOOSE PASS VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY

- WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management State Homeland Security Program ("SHSP") is a federal pass-through program under the Federal Emergency Management Agency which provides funding for planning, equipment and exercises; and
- WHEREAS, borough Ordinance 2014-19-29 approved and appropriated an SHSP grant on behalf of Moose Pass Volunteer Fire Company ("MPVFC") to purchase a mobile generator with trailer (assets); and
- WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management approved the borough's disposition request, allowing the MPVFC authorization to assume ownership of assets; and
- WHEREAS, the assembly finds it is in the best interest of the borough to transfer ownership of assets to the MPVFC;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to transfer the 18 KW diesel generator (SN# 1502093) and the vehicle trailer (VIN# AJGS131XFB502093) from the Office of Emergency Management to the Moose Pass Volunteer Fire Company.
- **SECTION 2.** The mayor is authorized to execute documents deemed necessary to transfer the assets, and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
