PC Meeting: October 8, 2018

Chugach Electric Association, Inc. proposes to lease a two-acre parcel of Borough land and enter into a lease agreement for the continued operation and maintenance of a communication tower site. The land proposed for lease is located in the Summit Lake area near Milepost 46 of the Seward Hwy. It is accessed off Tenderfoot Lane. Referring to page 96 of the packet, there is a map that shows the subject parcel.

The land subject to the lease was approved for conveyance to the Borough by the State of Alaska under a municipal land entitlement. In a memo dated August 27 2018 the Assessing Department determined a fair market value of \$68,300.00 for the two-acre parcel.

The rental rate is 8% and the lease is subject to a 3% annual escalation. The term of the lease is twenty years and contains one option to renew for an additional five-year term.

END OF STAFF REPORT

Chairman Martin opened the meeting for public comment, seeing and hearing no one the Chairman closed public hearing.

MOTION: Commissioner Ecklund moved, seconded by Commissioner Carluccio to recommend forwarding the Ordinance authorizing a lease of two acres to Chugach Electric Association on to the Assembly for approval.

Commissioner Foster wanted to know that when a lease like this is done and the lease holder decides to not continue the lease would the site need to be returned to original status. The question would be if concrete pads, roads and driveways would be left. Ms. Denison answered that typically the improvements should be returned. However, in cases where the Borough maybe placing communication equipment at the site, the options should be considered towards the end of the lease.
