RE: Amendment to Ordinance 2018-19-17, Appropriating Funds to the Legal Department for the Costs Associated with Hiring Outside Counsel to Represent the Kenai Peninsula Borough in the Application of the Alaska Gasline Development Corporation Filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Mayor)

As the law firm that the borough hired to represent it before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission has already provided services for the borough, it is requested that the assembly make the effective date of this ordinance retroactive to August 1, 2018. This would make the funds available to cover costs for services already provided. (Please note the bold underlined language is new and the bold strikeout language in brackets is to be deleted.)

Amend Section 2, as follows:
