Request to Extend Disaster Emergency Declaration Issued October 16,

2018

The administration respectfully requests that the assembly extend the Mayor's Disaster Emergency Declaration for the Kenai Peninsula Borough issued on October 16, 2018, for an additional 10 days, through November 2, 2018. Per AS 26.23.140 a local disaster emergency may not be continued or renewed more than seven days except with the consent of the governing body. The declaration of a local disaster emergency activates the response and recovery aspects of the applicable local inter-jurisdictional disaster emergency plans.

In the Seward area repair and recovery efforts are expected to continue up to an additional ten days. Extending the October 16, 2018 Disaster Emergency Declaration through November 2, 2018 would enable the borough to continue providing these services.
