Resolution 2019-<u>030</u>, Adopting a Policy to Affirmatively Further Fair

Housing (Mayor)

The borough accepted and appropriated a federal pass-through grant from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development under the U.S. Housing and Urban Development, "Community Development Block Grant" (CDBG) program for \$487,500 by way of Ordinance 2018-19-32. The grant will supplement the purchase of a pumper/tanker for the CES Funny River Fire Station #5. National policy requirements are imposed upon all federal grants, including the CDBG program.

This resolution updates the borough's former policy to affirmatively further fair housing as adopted by Resolution 2013-058. Additionally, this resolution recognizes the extent to which the borough may participate in furthering fair housing development and reflects national policy compliance as governed in the Catalogue of Federal Register, 24 C.F.R. Subtitle B, Chapter V, Subchapter C, Part 570.

Upon approval, this resolution replaces KPB Resolution 2013-058.
