Request Line Items

- Tuition Waivers (JumpStart) KPC-wide
 - \$199,657
 - 365 HS juniors & seniors paid \$71/credit vs \$202/credit
- ABE/GED KRC & KBC
 - \$153,149
 - 199 students, 37 GEDs awarded, 4,500 contact hours
 - Soldotna, Homer & outreach to Nanwalek, Port Graham,
 Voznesenska, Seldovia, Anchor Pt, Ninilchik, Nikiski
- Courses in Seward
 - \$32,301

7 classes offered; free office space/classrooms in HS

UNIVERSITY of ALASKA ANCHORAGE

- Coordinator/Night Staffing KRC
 - \$20,571
 - Provides registration, financial aid, security presence
- Library Support Position KBC
 - \$24,394 (60% of cost from KPB)
 - Services to 70+ faculty/staff, 100s of students
- Instructional Support position KBC
 - \$45,674
 - Proctored 881 tests, supported 12 staff & faculty
- Information/Registration Clerk KBC
 - \$33,439 (50% of cost from KPB)
 - Registers and refers students to resources



UNIVERSITY of ALASKA ANCHORAGE

- Tutors in the Learning Centers KRC & KBC
 - \$56,012
 - "Peer" students and non-student tutors trained & qualified in specific areas; 1,000+ sessions, 200+ students
- Developmental Student Advising KRC
 - \$91,465
 - 560 students advised, classroom visits, placement tests
- Student Advisor KBC
 - \$38,120
 - Admissions, financial aid, academic placement advising



UNIVERSITY of ALASKA ANCHORAGE

- VA & Safety Coordinator KPC-wide
 - \$76,928
 - Certified 359 veteran students, 59 KPC degree seekers
 - Coordinates, oversees safety compliance
- Recruiter KPC-wide
 - \$35,339 (35% of cost from KPB)
 - Visits KPB schools, college fairs, campus tours for 5th-12th graders. Interacted with 1,000+ potential students
- Peer Ambassador Scholars KPC-wide
 - \$10,704
 - Three KRC students, one KBC. Support academic events on campuses; sometimes accompanies recruiter

- FY17 \$1.3M
- FY18 \$220K
- FY19 +\$80K

Financial Aid Disbursements

 In FY18, \$1,411,006 provided to admitted KPC degree-seeking students after we deduct tuition & fees.

These monies are spent on the Peninsula for housing, food, & other living expenses.
