The following are proposed adjustments to the FY2020 budget for your consideration:

## **Budget Amendments**

- The FY2020 shared custodial services bids for Purchasing and Contracting, Roads and Solid Waste were higher than anticipated. Therefore, we are requesting an increase of \$1,550 to Purchasing and Contracting Contract Services line 100.11227.43011 page 76. Roads and Solid Waste will absorb the increase into the existing proposed FY2020 budget.
- 2. It is being proposed that an additional \$50,000 be appropriated to the Finance Department, Sales Tax Division Page 114 Contract Services 100.11441.43011 to allow the Finance Department to investigate and potentially contract with a temporary lodging location software vendor in order to assist in compliance monitoring in the borough.
- 3. Pursuant to KPB 1.26.020, changes, additions and deletions to the Schedule of Rates, Charges and Fees may be adopted by ordinance through the annual budgetary process. The following rates/changes are being proposed to be adopted in addition to the terms already listed, effective FY2020, Page 424 & 425:
