WHEREAS, estimates indicate this increase would generate approximately \$<u>3.1</u> million to \$<u>3.4</u> million annually in revenue to the borough, which would help to protect the unrestricted fund balance in future years at current borough spending levels; and

Amend Section 3, as follows:

SECTION 3. That Sections 2 and 3 shall become effective immediately upon enactment of this ordinance. Section 1 of this ordinance shall become effective <u>January 1</u>, 2020, only if the proposition contained in Section 2 is approved by a majority of voters voting on the question in the regular election of October 1 2019.
