AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR WINTER STORM RESPONSE IN VARIOUS AREAS OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

- WHEREAS, the Borough Mayor issued a declaration of disaster emergency on December 6, 2019, relating to sustained severe damage caused by an ongoing storm weather event, including high winds, heavy snowfall, icy conditions, heavy rain and flooding in numerous areas of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and
- **WHEREAS**, the declaration seeks state assistance as the borough has expended significant resources relating to the response to the storm damage; and
- **WHEREAS,** this declaration continues for a period of seven days, until December 13, 2019, unless extended by consent of the assembly; and
- **WHEREAS,** as the repair and recovery efforts continue and is expected to require the ongoing use of borough resources, it is appropriate to extend the disaster declaration; and
- **WHEREAS**, the assembly wishes to extend this declaration in the best interests of the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the declaration of local disaster emergency previously issued by the borough mayor on December 6, 2019, is hereby extended for a period of 30 days in order to allow for a more complete response. A copy of the declaration of disaster emergency extended by this resolution is attached and incorporated herein by reference.
- **SECTION 2.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
