Homer HS – Attic Roof Ventilation and Gutters The current original shake roof was installed in 1985, is no longer in warranty, and is deteriorating. Additionally, attic ventilation has proven to be inadequate, and the internal gutter system is no longer functioning to protect the building from leakage. In order to properly address the internal gutters and ventilation system the entire roof will need to be replaced.	\$ 8,271,734.00	Homer
West Homer El – North Wall Sealing Shortly after construction, the north wall constructed of fluted concrete block started allowing moisture penetration into the building. This has subsequently caused damage to surfaces, and has contributed to mold growth. 




