## Changes in River Center Staffing

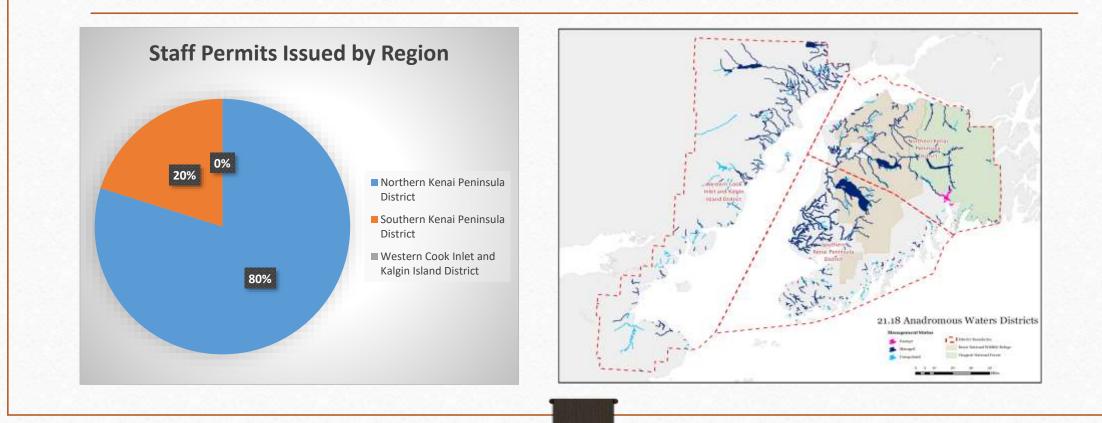

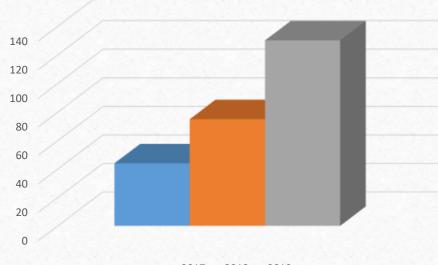
# Staff Permits by Type

- Fences- 3

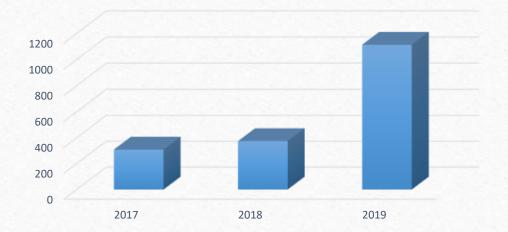


## Minor Vegetation Management

### Changes Under My Tenure

- Phytoremediation at Road-Stream Crossings
- Increased Public Outreach via Site Visits, Educational Talks, and Renewal of the Newsletter
- Updated and Revamped Habitat Protection Tax Credit Program
- Increased Focus on Habitat Improvement and Mitigation for Violations (Proposed Changes under AWHPWG)

## Budget Reductions

- Overall: -15.35%
  - Personnel- -20.69%

\*Removal of unfilled position

• Supplies- **4.64%** 

\*Reductions in fuels, oils, and lubricants, computer software, repair and maintenance supplies

• Services- -5.91%

\*Reductions in postage and freight, dues and subscriptions, advertising, and contractual services

# Budget Increases

- Supplies
  - Uniforms- 7.69%
    - \* Uniforms for new staff
  - Motor Vehicle Supplies- **300%** 
    - \* New Tires
  - Small Tools and Minor Equipment- 16.67%
    - \* Ground maintenance purchases

- Services
  - Transportation/Subsistence- 16.67%
    - \* West Side Site Visits, training travel for new staff
  - Training- 8.76%
    - \* Increased Training opportunities for new staff
  - Equipment Maintenance- 28%
    - \* Konica Minolta Contract
