

In ordinance 2020-29, as described in Section 3, it is my intent “Second Amendment Sanctuary” means the borough supports the protection of second amendment rights and will not spend borough funds or resources, or use borough employees, buildings or offices to restrict second amendment rights or assist in enforcing any unnecessary and unconstitutional restriction of second amendment rights to keep and bear arms.

It does not mean the borough assumes the authority to decide what laws violate the second amendment rights. Additionally, as the borough has no law enforcement authority it would not ordinarily be involved in enforcing any such laws.
