Amendments to Resolution 2020-057, Amending the Spending Plan Approved in Resolutions 2020-047 and 2020-056 for Cares Act Coronavirus Relief Funds Received from the State of Alaska (Mayor)

Two amendments are proposed to resolution 2020—57.

➤ The first amendment would amend the borough's Coronavirus Relief Fund (CFR) Spending Plan approved in R2020-047 and R2020-057. The plan addresses budget revisions necessary to achieve individual project outcomes.

These revisions include:

- 1) Provides additional funds to the small business/nonprofit/senior citizen center grant programs for program administration and support.
- 2) Shifts additional funds from the revenue recoup category to the second distribution to small businesses/nonprofits based on estimated outcome of the borough's revenue collections, estimated ending position for FY2020 and updated revenues projections for FY2021.
- 3) Reduces the amount allocated to EMS personnel costs based on reduced estimated costs for the reminder of the quarter.
- 4) Reduces the GIS update for remote assessing project allocation due to the actual project costs being less than originally estimated.

➤ Insert a new Section 2 as follows and renumber the existing Section 2 to Section 3:

SECTION 2.
