If the protest is a "conditional protest" as defined in 3 AAC 306.060(d)(2) and the application otherwise meets all the criteria set forth by the regulations, the Marijuana Control Board may approve the license, but require the applicant to show to the board's satisfaction that the requirements of the local government have been met before the director issues the license.

3 AAC 306.010, 3 AAC 306.080, and 3 AAC 306.250 provide that the board will deny an application for a new license if the board finds that the license is prohibited under AS 17.38 as a result of an ordinance or election conducted under AS 17.38 and 3 AAC 306.200, or when a local government protests an application on the grounds that the proposed licensed premises are located in a place within the local

government where a local zoning ordinance prohibits the marijuana establishment, unless the local government has approved a variance from the local ordinance.

This application will be in front of the Marijuana Control Board at our 3/31-4/1, 2021 meeting.

What is this form?

An operating plan is required for all marijuana establishment license applications. Applicants should review **Title 17.38 of Alaska Statutes and Chapter 306 of the Alaska Administrative Code**. This form will be used to document how an applicant intends to meet the requirements of those statutes and regulations. If your business has a formal operating plan, you may include a copy of that operating plan with your application, but all fields of this form must still be completed per 3 AAC 306.020(c).

What must be covered in an operating plan?

Applicants must identify how the proposed premises will comply with applicable statutes and regulations regarding the following:

- Employee qualification and training

All persons entering the establishment will be required to present valid photo ID. All staff are to be trained to examine the presented identification for:

A: type/condition and validity/acceptability of identification

B: Date of Birth

C: Photo matches person presenting the ID

D: Expiration date

Section 3 – Security

Restricted Access Areas (3 AAC 306.710):

3.1. Describe how you will prevent unescorted members of the public from entering restricted access areas:

Restricted areas are clearly delineated by signage, and all doors to this facility are posted "restricted area, all visitors must be escorted" in addition to every door requiring a key or code to gain entry.

3.2. Describe your recordkeeping and processes for admitting visitors into and escorting them through restricted access areas:

All visitors must present valid ID, sign in, be issued a visitor's badge, and must be accompanied by staff at all times. A 1:5 minimum employee to visitor ratio will be maintained. Sign in includes ID #, reason for visit, visitors badge #, date, time, and visitor's signature and printed name.

Security Alarm Systems and Lock Standards (3 AAC 306.715):

3.4. Exterior lighting is required to facilitate surveillance. Describe how the exterior lighting will meet this requirement:

All exterior lighting is on a photocell, and all surveillance cameras are designed for night vision as a secondary precaution. The entire exterior perimeter is lit.

3.5. An alarm system is required for all license types that must be activated on all exterior doors and windows when the licensed premises is closed for business. Describe the security alarm system for the proposed premises, explain how it will meet all regulatory requirements, and outline your policies and procedures regarding the actions to be taken by a licensee, employee, or agent when the alarm system alerts of an unauthorized breach:

The alarm system is monitored by an off site company. The control panel is located within the retail area behind the counter. All exterior exits are sensed, with motion detectors located within any area having an exit to the exterior.

In the event of an alarm, the licensee or manager is notified and can access the system remotely while the monitoring company is notifying the authorities. If motion is detected within the facility, the licensee/manager is to also notify the authorities and advise them of the situation, and then proceed to the facility to await the authorities and assist them in gaining entry and searching and securing the premises.

3.6. Describe your policies and procedures for preventing diversion of marijuana or marijuana product, including by employees:

All cannabis products are under constant surveillance, and are subject to daily count/audit. In the event of a discrepancy, the surveillance footage is to be reviewed. Any person found to be diverting products will be immediately reported to both the police and AMCO, and footage/evidence will be forwarded so as to aid in prosecution and/or applicable AMCO proceedings.

3.7. Describe your policies and procedures for preventing loitering:

No loitering signs are to be posted on the property, and upon noticing such activity, a manager/assistant manager will ask how they may help the person, and if no valid reason for being there is forthcoming, the person will be asked to leave the property. If the person refuses to leave, or fails to comply, or escalates the situation the police are to be called, and that person is to be trespassed from the property.

The entire exterior perimeter is to be under surveillance, with opposing view cameras (2) on every side. All rooms that may at any time contain cannabis products, or an exit to the exterior are to have at least two opposing cameras with diagonally opposed views so that the entire room is under surveillance coverage

3.14. Describe the locked and secure area where video surveillance recording equipment and original copies of surveillance records will be housed and stored, and how you will ensure the area is accessible only to authorized personnel, law enforcement, or an agent of the Marijuana Control Board. If you will be using an offsite monitoring service and offsite storage of video surveillance records, your response must include how the offsite facility will meet these security requirements:

All security cameras terminate to a 40 TB DVR located within the vault that is entirely of poured concrete. No access to the vault is permitted except by management or appropriately authorized persons. The memory capacity is sufficient to maintain video footage for a minimum of 40 days, so as to have said footage available to AMCO or applicable authorities upon request.

- g. all records normally retained for tax purposes;
- h. accurate and comprehensive inventory tracking records that account for all marijuana inventory activity from seed or immature plant stage until the retail marijuana or retail marijuana product is sold to a consumer, to another marijuana establishment, or destroyed;
- i. transportation records for marijuana and marijuana product, as required by 3 AAC 306.750(f); and
- j. registration and inspection reports of scales registered under the Weights and Measures Act, as required by 3 AAC 306.745.

All required records are to be maintained on site in hard copy form for one year, and also scanned and transferred to an external hard drive to be additionally stored on site for the requisite term. After one year, hard copies may be stored off site, but digital copies on external hard drive(s) will be available on site for the remainder of the required term.

All staff will be educated in marijuana regulations, safe practices in the handling of cannabis, operation and security protocols, an overview of METRC, proper examination of presented ID, required reporting protocols, and proper cleaning, hygiene, and waste handling procedures.

All cannabis and cannabis products subject to transport will be weighed and sealed in a package with weight/amount of product and gross weight of the total package clearly marked, along with the strain/contents. All packages will have a METRC package tag affixed. Sealed packages then go into a rigid, lockable container, that is then secured with a lock and/or a tamper resistant fastener/closure. All transportation of cannabis and/or cannabis products is to be done by persons in possession of a valid MJ handler's card, and with all information clearly documented by METRC manifest.

Any vehicle transporting marijuana or marijuana product will travel directly from the shipping marijuana establishment to the receiving marijuana establishment, and will not make any unnecessary stops in between except to deliver or pick up marijuana or marijuana product at any other licensed marijuana establishment.

8.7. When the marijuana establishment receives marijuana or marijuana product from another licensed marijuana establishment, the recipient of the shipment will use the marijuana inventory tracking system to report the type, amount, and weight of marijuana or marijuana product received.

A detailed diagram of the proposed licensed premises is required for all marijuana establishment license applications, per 3 AAC 306.020(b)(8). **All areas designated as the licensed premises of a single license must be contiguous. All diagrams must have the licensed premises area labeled, and outlined or shaded as appropriate.**

What must be submitted with this form?

Applicants must attach multiple diagrams to this form, including (as applicable):

- **Diagram 1:**
a diagram showing only the licensed premises areas that will be ready to be **operational at the time of your preliminary inspection** and license issuance;
- **Diagram 2:**
if different than Diagram 1, a diagram outlining **all areas for which the licensee has legal right of possession** (a valid lease or deed), and clearly showing those areas' relationship to the current proposed licensed premises (*details of any planned expansion areas do not need to be included; a complete copy of Form MJ-14: Licensed Premises Diagram Change must be submitted and approved before any planned expansion area may be added to the licensed premises*);
- **Diagram 3:**
a **site plan or as-built of the entire lot**, showing all structures on the property and clearly indicating which area(s) will be part of the licensed premises;
- **Diagram 4:**
an **aerial photo of the entire lot and surrounding lots**, showing a view of the entire property and surrounding properties, and clearly indicating which area(s) will be part of the licensed premises (*this can be obtained from sources like Google Earth*); and
- **Diagram 5:**
a diagram of the **entire building in which the licensed premises is located**, clearly distinguishing the licensed premises from unlicensed areas and/or premises of other licenses within the building. If your proposed licensed premises is located within a building or building complex that contains multiple business and/or tenants, please provide the addresses and/or suite numbers of the other businesses and/or tenants (*a separate diagram is not required for an establishment that is designating the entire building as a single licensed premises*).

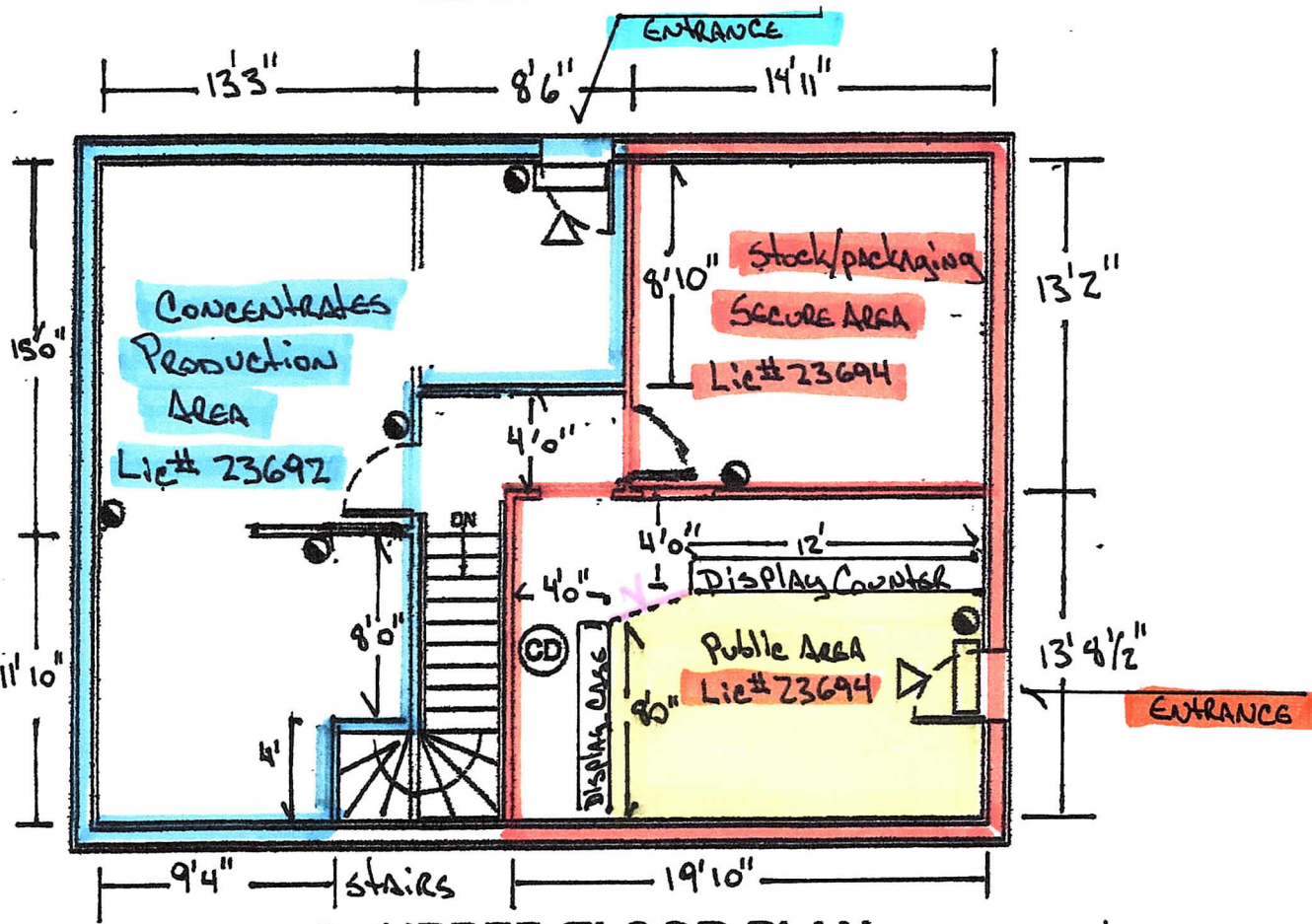

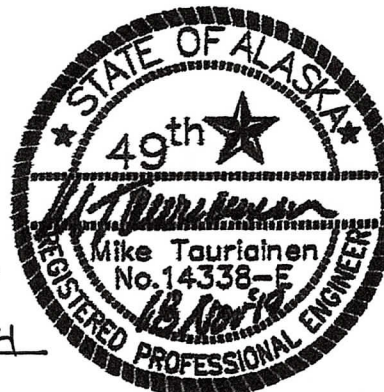

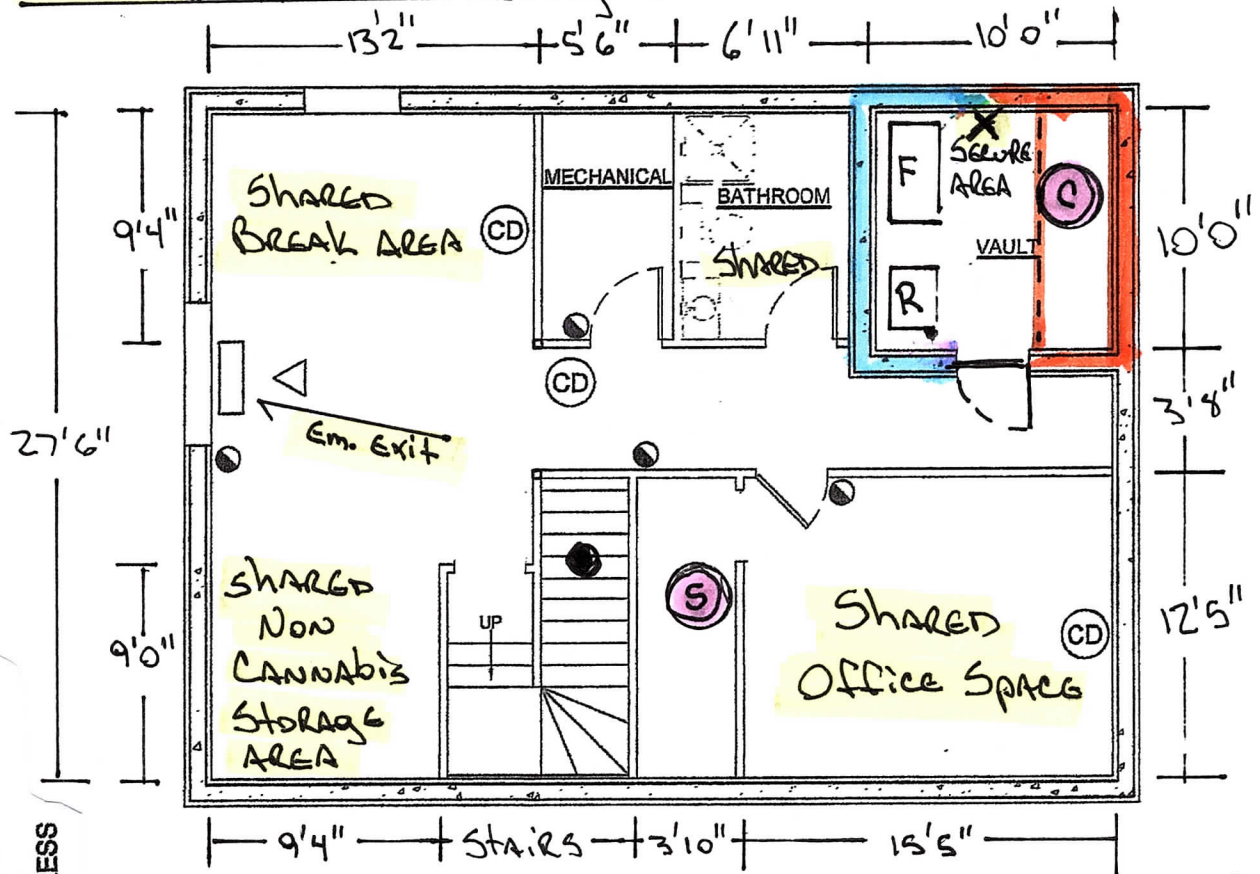

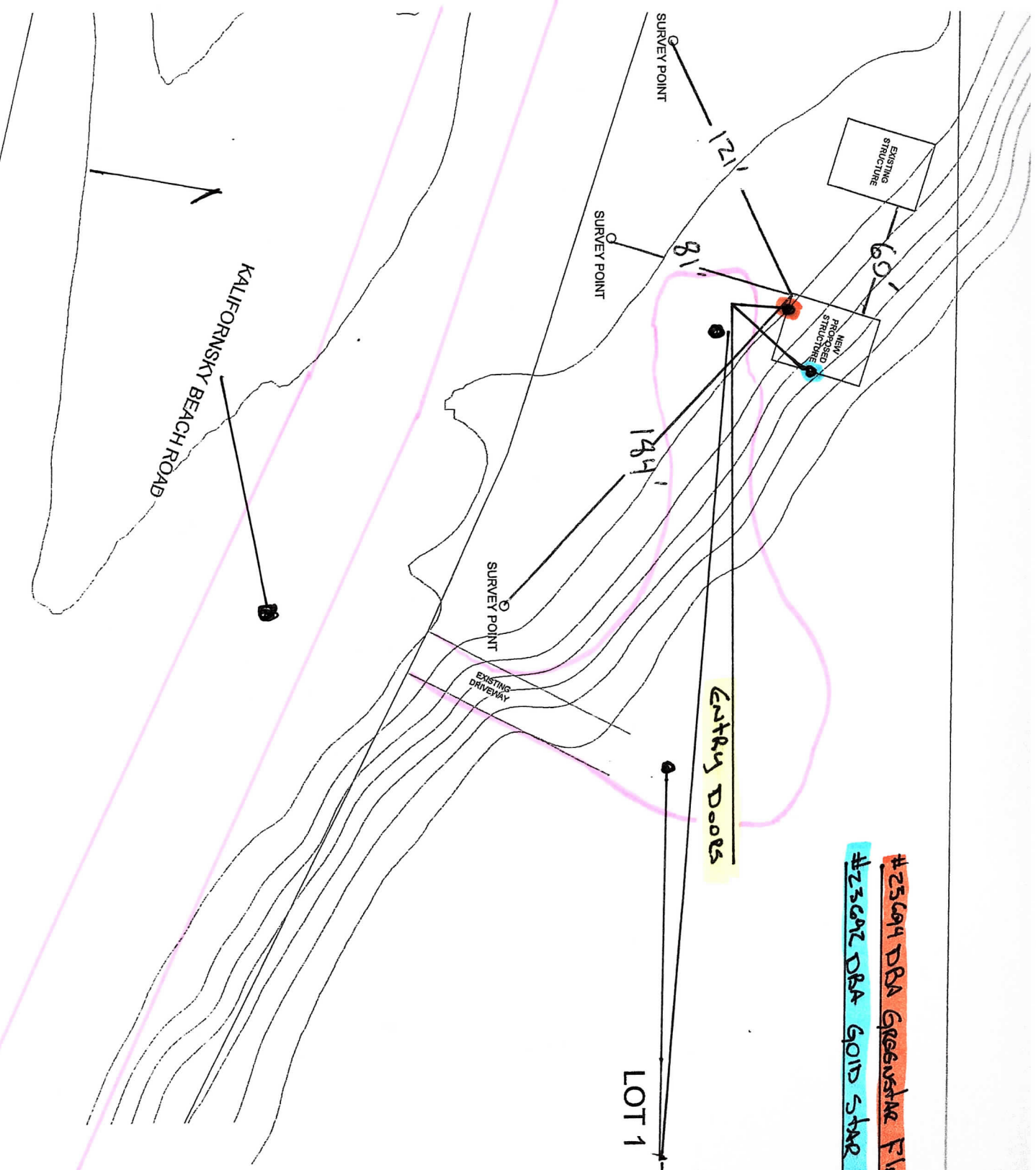

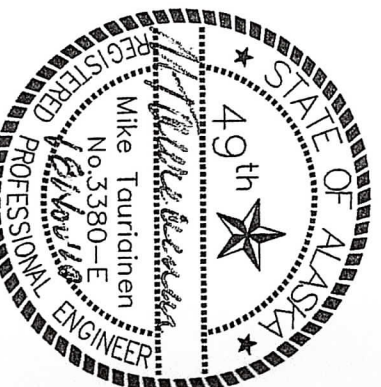

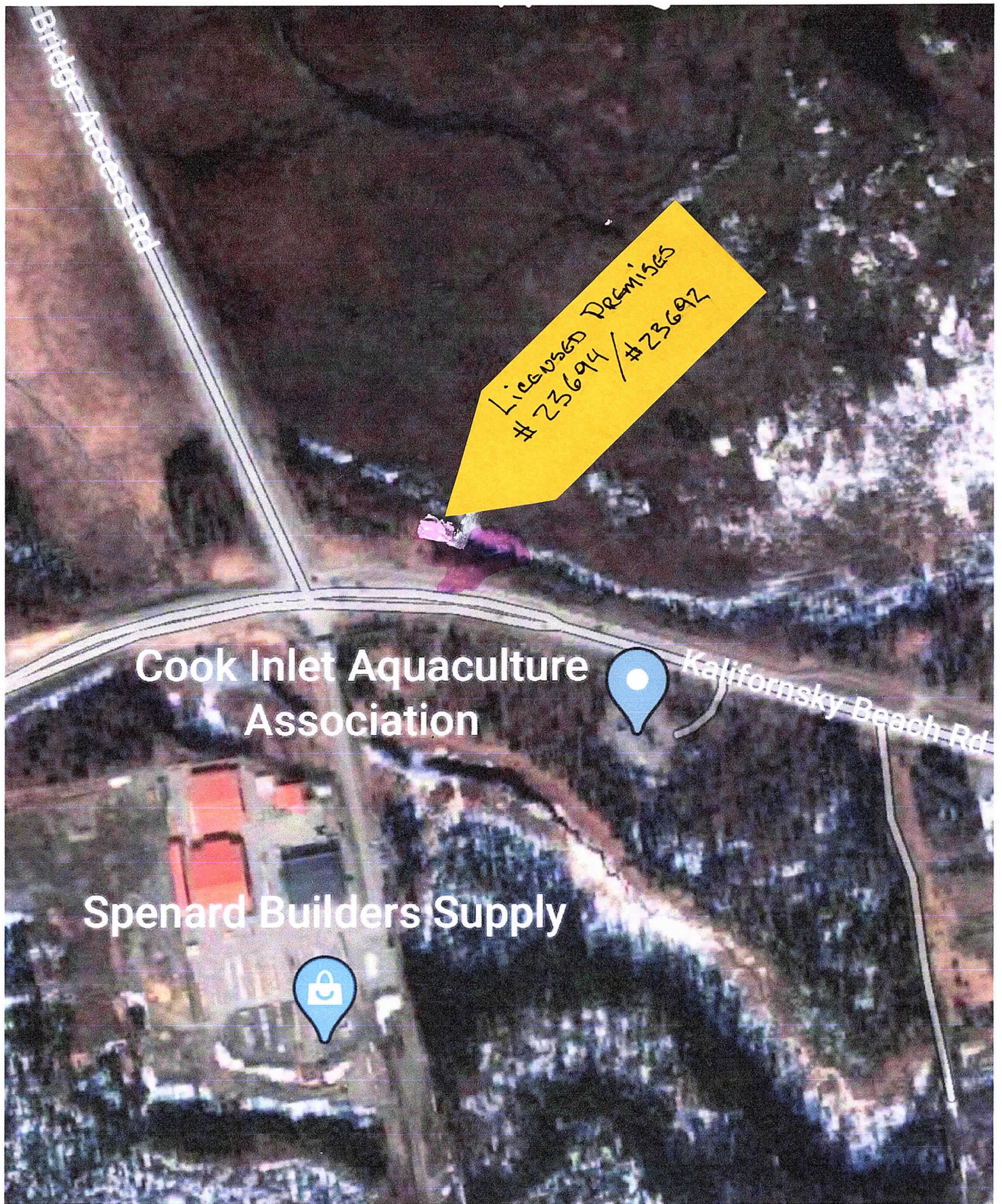

All incoming cannabis materials are to be accompanied by a valid METRC manifest, and transported by persons in possession of a valid MJ Handler's card. Upon arrival at the facility, the transporter must present valid ID to be examined for DOB, photo match, condition/acceptability, expiration as staff are trained/required to do. After being signed into the facility as a visitor, transporter is escorted to restricted area where the manifest and package(s) are examined and weighed. All packages must have a METRC package tag affixed, and tag #, contents and weight must match the manifest or the package is rejected. Transporter is paid upon acceptance of manifested packages in Metrc, signed out, and escorted to their vehicle for safety.

From this point, packages either go to the vault for secure storage, or directly to processing area. Processing for Trim will either entail Ice water extraction, or dry sifting depending on its target end product, while flower may be directed to either ice water extraction or Rosin press stations for processing. Depending on targeted end product, cannabis material may be further refined from these points. All cannabis products are followed through the entire process by their applicable METRC package or batch tags.

Post manufacturing, all concentrate products are segregated and securely stored, with associated METRC batch tags, until testing is complete and results received.

Upon receipt of testing results, product is then weighed, packaged, and labeled as required per regulation, while type of packaging may vary depending on individual product specifics.

All transfers of product from the facility are to be tagged and manifested through METRC, and transported to their end destination licensees by persons in possession of a valid MJ handler's card. Packages as tagged and manifested are placed in a rigid, lockable transport container, and secured with a lock or tamper evident closure device for transport. All transfers are to be accompanied by their applicable Metrc manifest, and all packages will have package tags affixed, and be clearly labeled with count/weight of the contents, and gross weight of the package.

Liquid waste from the ice water extraction process will be dumped down the sink as per our DEC approved wastewater plan, as it is only R.O. water tinted green with chlorophyll, with all solids classified out via the mesh sieves.

The organic ethanol will be reclaimed and purified utilizing the Roto-Vap, and is then able to be reused. Any residual waste generated by this process will essentially be waxes or minute amounts of cannabis oils, and will be subsequently also mixed with soil and disposed of in the afore mentioned locked dumpster after notification to AMCO and the expiration of the 3 day period.

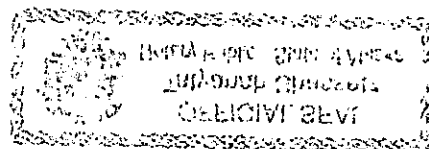

ARTICLE I
OFFICES

1. **Registered Office and Agent.** The registered or statutory office of the Corporation in the State of Alaska is at 35835 Ryan Lane, Soldotna, Alaska, 99669. The registered, statutory or resident agent of the Corporation at such office is JASON BOTT.

2. **Other Places of Business.** Branch or subordinate offices or places of business may be established at any time by the Board if Directors at any place or places where the corporation is qualified to do business.

ARTICLE II
SHAREHOLDERS

1. **Annual Meeting.** The annual meeting of shareholders shall be held upon not less than ten nor more than fifty days written notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting, at 10 o'clock a.m. on the 15th day of the May of each year at the principal office of the Corporation or at such other time and place as shall be specified in the notice of meeting, in order to elect directors and transact such other business as shall come before the meeting, including the election of any officers as required by law. OFFICES

1. **Election.** At its regular meeting following the annual meeting of the shareholders, the Board shall elect a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer, except such officers as shall be elected by the shareholders. One person may hold two or more offices, but no person shall hold the office of president and secretary at the same time.

2. **Duties and Authority of President.** The president shall be chief executive officer of the Corporation. 5. **Duties and Authority of Secretary.** The Secretary shall cause notices of all meetings to be served as prescribed in these By-laws and shall keep or cause to be kept the minutes of all meetings of the shareholders and the be kept the minutes of all meetings of the shareholders and the Board. The secretary shall have charge of the seal of Board. The secretary shall perform such other duties and possess such other powers as are incident to that office or as are assigned by the president or the Board.

6. **Removal of Officers.** The Board may remove any officer or agent of the Corporation if such action, in the judgment of the Board, is in the best interest of the Corporation. Appointment or election to a corporate office shall not, of itself, establish or create contract rights.

7. **Vacancies in Offices.** The Board, in its absolute discretion, may fill all vacancies in offices, regardless of the cause of such vacancies, for the remainder of the terms of the offices.

ARTICLE VI

AMENDMENTS TO AND EFFECT OF BY-LAWS

1. **Force and Effect of By-laws.** These By-laws are subject to the provisions of the laws of the State of Alaska and the Corporation's Certificate of Incorporation, as it may be amended from time to time.
