Request Line Items

- Tuition Waivers (JumpStart) KPC-wide
 - \$240,000
 - HS juniors & seniors will pay \$79/credit vs \$234/credit
 - Spring 20 Students: 169 (9 schools, 3 homeschool)
 - Spring 20 Credit Hours: 749
 - Fall 20 Students: 185 (7 schools, 2 homeschool)
 - Fall 20 Credit Hours: 845
- ABE/GED KRC & KBC
 - \$139,390
 - Soldotna, Homer, Kenai, Nanwalek, Port Graham,
 Voznesenka, Seldovia, Anchor Pt, Ninilchik, Nikiski



- Tutors in the Learning Centers KRC & KBC
 - \$45,946
 - "Peer" students and non-student tutors trained & qualified in specific areas
- Courses in Seward
 - \$32,316
 - Free office space/classrooms in HS
- Coordinator/Night Staffing KRC
 - \$21,753 (50% of cost from KPB)
 - Provides registration, financial aid, security presence



- Student Success & Resource Advisor KRC
 - \$90,939
 - Advising at risk students, classroom visits, placement tests
- Admin/Instructional Support position KBC
 - \$49,887
 - Proctors tests, supports 12 staff & faculty
- Library Technician KBC
 - \$24,514 (60% of cost from KPB)
 - Services to 70+ faculty/staff, 100s of students



- Information/Registration Clerk KBC
 - \$34,803 (50% of cost from KPB)
 - Registers and refers students to resources
- Advising & Student Support Services- KBC
 - \$41,689 (60% of cost from KPB)
 - Admissions, financial aid, academic placement advising
- Veteran Services KPC-wide
 - \$90,387
 - Certifies veteran students VA eligibility and advises vets and active duty military



- Recruiter KPC-wide
 - \$39,225 (50% of cost from KPB)
 - Visits KPB schools, college fairs, campus tours for 5th-12th graders. Interacts with 1,000+ potential students. Past year via Zoom.

Financial Aid Disbursements

 In FY21, \$921,399 provided to admitted KPC degree-seeking students after we deduct tuition & fees.

These monies are spent across the Peninsula on housing, food, & other living expenses.
