



Donald E. Gilman River Center: FY2021 Overview

- Loss of RC Manager in July 2020
- Continued to provide services despite 25% staff reduction
- Reviewed and issued 440 permits
- Completed \$10,400 riverbank restoration at River Center
- 21.18 Anadromous Waters Habitat Protection Working Group & Code revisions
- Completed annual recertification in Community Rating System
- Upgrades to main conference room to allow for social distancing

- AWR Engineering Study (Seward)
 - Provides flood depths to 3 neighborhoods in Seward
- 21.06 Floodplain Management code revision
- Started working with FEMA for new Kenai River floodplain maps

- Continue working with IT to update tech in large conference room
- Increase public outreach efforts
 - Increase site visits, annual presentations, educational outreach
 - Work with Kenai Watershed Forum on Stream Watch
 - Assist Kenai Watershed Forum in seeking grant funding for a more robust educational outreach program geared toward property owner education




