CITY OF HOMER 1 2 HOMER, ALASKA City Manager 3 4 **RESOLUTION 21-054** 5 6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR A JOINT RESOLUTION WITH THE 7 8 KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH FOR THE FEDERAL FUNDING REQUEST OF \$35 MILLION TO MITIGATE THE SPRUCE BARK 9 BEETLE INFESTATION THAT HAS RESURGED ON THE KENAI 10 11 PENINSULA. 12 WHEREAS, In the 1990's over one million acres of forest were impacted by spruce bark 13 14 beetle infestation; and 15 WHEREAS, A resurgence of Spruce Bark Beetle infestation was confirmed in 2019 with 16 aerial detection surveying showing 150,000 acres of damage; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, Since 2005 rampant fires have cost taxpayers more than \$8 million per year 20 in direct suppression costs alone; and 21 WHEREAS, Dead spruce has reduced commercial value and creates dire implications for 22 fire rise on the Peninsula as seen most recently in the 2019 Swan Lake fire; and 23 24 WHEREAS, The Western Beetle Mitigation Forest Crisis Response Federal Funding 25 Request for \$35 million to Senator Murkowski from the Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB) 26 identifies project objectives to mitigate infestation and create defensible space across all 27 municipal lands and provide assistance to residential properties in or along the wildland urban 28 29 interface. 30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska hereby 31 supports a joint resolution with the Kenai Peninsula Borough for the \$35 million federal 32 funding request for Spruce Bark Beetle mitigation on the Kenai Peninsula. 33 34 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign a letter of support and/or a future joint resolution supporting the request of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to 36 secure funding from the Alaska U.S. Congressional Delegation for spruce bank beetle 37 mitigation. 38 39 PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Homer City Council this 9th day of August, 2021. 40
