Capital Planning Update

- > A area wide 5 year capital planning process is being developed.
- ➤ The objective of the capital planning process is to provide KPB and its agencies with an area wide comprehensive, structured capital planning process for it and it's agency needs.
- ➤ Noting that the School District Facilities make up about 75% of KPB assets, a steering group of KPB and KPBSD administrative representatives has been created to Identify Capital priorities, Facility Maintenance roles/responsibilities, cooperative policies, and operating agreements.



Maintenance

To achieve short term improvements and lay the foundation for future improvements, the Maintenance Department is working on the following efforts;

- Evaluate and change the roles and responsibly of Maintenance positions.
- Improve our Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS) to focus on a preventative maintenance program priority.
- Implementation of life cycle planning.
- Improvements to Warehouse inventory management.

Priority A Projects

- A Highest Priority.
- The Facility no longer meets the needs of the program it supports.
- Existing facility/asset is deteriorating past regular maintenance and needs replacement or renovation.
- New construction necessary to address an Agency or Borough need.
