McClure moved to amend Ordinance 2015-02 as follows:

Section 1 to read:

"Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby amende

adding a new chapter to be numbered KPB 10.14 which shall read as follows:

#### CHAPTER 10.14 MARIJUANA CONTROL

10.14.010. Prohibition. The operation of marijuana cultivation facilities other than personal use as authorized by AS 17.38.020 is prohibited in the area of the borough on the cities.

10.14.020. Definitions. The terms used in this chapter have the same meaning as defined in AS 17.38.900 as now enacted or may be amended.", and

Section 2 to read:

"Section 2. That a proposition shall be placed before the voters of the Kenai Peni Borough for the regular election to be held on October 6, 2015, which reads as follows:

PROPOSITION No. \_\_\_\_

Shall Ordinance 2015-02, which [ESTABLISHES A NEW CHAPTER IN THE KENAI PENIN BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED CHAPTER 10.14 - MARIJUANA CON PROHIBITING] prohibits the operation of [COMMERCIAL] marijuana cultivation facilities than for personal use as authorized by AS 17.38.020, in the area of the Kenai Peni Borough outside of the cities, be enacted?

Yes \_\_\_\_\_ A "yes" vote means marijuana cultivation facilities, other than for persona as authorized by AS 17.38.020, will be prohibited in the area of the borough outside crities

No \_\_\_\_\_ A "no" vote means marijuana cultivation facilities will not be prohibited in the area of the borough outside of the cities."

This Ordinance was amended.

No: 2 - Haggerty, and Cooper

Assembly Members Wolf, Wells and Gilman spoke in support of Ordinance 2015-02.

Assembly Members Cooper, McClure, Ogle, Haggerty and Johnson spoke in opposition to Ordinance 2015-02.

McClure moved that this Ordinance be enact as amended. The motion failed by the following vote:

No: 6 - Ogle, Bagley, Johnson, Haggerty, McClure, and Cooper
